Ten Most Common Violations Found In DRE Audits

s the real estate Industry movesF things From Fup Feveryday FtoF change the way we Ho business. NewF terms, such as E-Loans, Internet Mar-F keting, and E-Form have become jar-F gons of the trade. Yet, certain thingsF have Flot changed – the most commonF violations found in DRE Audits. In this F regard, the second half of the top tenF common Fiolations Fare Fisted Below.F (Part I was printed in the Summer 2000F) issue.) The purpose of this article is toF call Four Ettention Fo These CommonF deficiencies and to brovide you with F procedures that you can follow to en-F sure compliance with these Faws and F regulations.F

Regulation 2832.1 - Trust Fund Handling for Multiple Beneficiaries (Trust Fund Shortage)

Regulation 2832.1 requires the realx estate kroker tx obtain written consentx from every owner of the trust funds inx the bank account prior to each disburse-x ment xf xhe xlisbursement xvill xeducex the sbalance sof the stunds in the sbankx account to an amount dess than thex existing trust fund kiability of the bro-x ker to all owners of the funds. A trustx fund shortage therefore exists when thex following conditions are present:x

- funds; andx
- from all owners of the trust fundsx allowing this.x

The most abvious reason for a trustx into Fa Fnew Fmillennium, FnewF fund schortage is the intentional misusex (conversion) of trust funds. However, x simple xecord xeeping xerrors xhat xe-x main xindetected xould xesult xin xrustx fund schortages and an actual doss ofx funds. xFailure xto xrecord xa xdisburse-x ment, wr understating the amount xf ax check xdisbursed, xor xoverstating xthex amount of a deposit x the beneficiaryx ledger/record will cause the beneficiaryx ledger to show a balance that is largerx than the true amount owed to the indi-x vidual beneficiary. This overstated bal-x ance on the ledger is more likely to bex paid and, consequently, the beneficiaryx will be paid more than what is due. Thex end result is a trust fund shortage.x

Regulation 2832 - Trust Fund Handling

AB 2284 (Dutra) Real Estate-**Escrow**

This shill xontains xDepartment-x sponsored provisions to authorize thex Commissioner tx deny, suspend, xr re-x voke x xeal x state x icense x x x ases x fx non-payment of wharges for audit andx preparation of delinquent reports. Also, x amends the required report format forx multi-lender transactions to include thex broker's xidentification xnumber, xele-x phone number, fiscal near, loan nervic-x ing xolume, the xervicing agent's ad-x dress and telephone number, if appli-x cable, and the extent of multi-lenderx transaction activity. This bill also in-x cludes some technical changes and otherx provisions not reponsored by the De-x partment.x

AB 2234 (Wiggins) Prepaid Rental Listing Service License (PRLS)

Makes various changes to the PRLSx law. It enables e-commerce, increasesx bonding xamounts xand xdoubles xhex amount which the kicensee may retainx as a xervice x harge x when a x efund x sx demanded.x

AB 860 (Thomson) Common Interest Developments (CIDs) Pets

Would allow CID and mobilehomex residents to have domestic paets subjectx law x January k, 2001, the bail's parovi-x sions would anly be affective for news subdivisions for governing adocumentsx entered into our amended after that date.x

Regulation 2834 - Trust Account Withdrawals

Commissioner's x Regulationx 2834(a) states that withdrawals may beex made from axtrust fund account of anx individual baroker anly upon the signa-x ture of the broker or one or more of thex following paersons in specifically autho-x rized in writing by the broker:x

- 1.x A xalesperson kicensed to the bro-x ker.x
- 2.x A person kicensed as a broker whox has xentered xinto xa xwritten xagree-x ment pursuant to Section 2/726 withx the broker.x
- 3.x An unlicensed employee of the bro-x ker with fidelity bond coverage atx least equal to the maximum amountx of xtrust xfunds xtx which xthe xem-x ployee has access at any time.x

Regulation 2834(b) also states thatx upon the xignature wf:x

- 1.x An officer through whom the cor-x poration is licensed pursuant to Sec-x tion k0158 or k0211 of the &ode; orx
- tion 2834(a), perovided that specific trust founds.x authorization in writing is given byx the afficer through whom the xor-x B & P Code Section 10240 poration is licensed and the afficerx Written Disclosure Statement is an authorized asignatory of thex trust fund account.x

broker or broker-officer is responsiblex or hiable for the handling of trust fundsx thorization x given x egarding x ignaturex authority.x

The most common wiolations foundx are:x

- 1.x The failure of the broker or desig-x nated refficer to be a xignatory x the trust account (this may Sindicatex a supervision problem).x
- 2.x Presence x f xan xunlicensed xsigna-x up xwith xhe xever-changing xopportuni-x tory x the trust account who doesx not have fidelity bond coverage.x
- 3.x Fidelity bond goverage in an inad-x equate amount and/or lass accheduct-x ible.x
- 4.x The failure of the broker or desig-x nated officer to give specific writ-x ten authorization permitting a sales-x person, broker or unlicensed per-x son to sign on the trust account.x

B & P Code Section 10145/ Regulation 2835 - Commingling

A baroker shall not commingle withx his wor her wwn money xr property thex money or property of others which hex or whe receives and sholds. Commonx causes of this violation are the depositx of trust funds received into the broker'sx general xbusiness xaccount xor xmainte-x nance of over \$200 in broker funds is ax trust account holding trust funds.x

A xommon xxample x this xiola-x withdrawals may be made from a trustx tion is when a broker ideposits creditx fund account of a corporate broker only report sfees and/or appraisal sfees are-x ceived xinto shis xor sher xgeneral xbankx account instead of a trust account when x he our she has not wet paid the bail. Another xoften-cited wiolation xisx Section x 0240 x of the x ode x which xe-x Regulation £2834(c) states that xax quires brokers to provide a borrowerx with axmortgage loan disclosure xtate-x ment within three business tlays afterx regardless not the rexistence not any au-x receipt of a completed loan applicationx or before the borrower becomes poli-x gated x the note, whichever is earlier.x Real estate brokers eften fail to providex the Mortgage Loan Disclosure State-x ment (Borrower) oxr, in axfederally regu-x lated xesidential xnortgage xxan xrans-x action, xfail xto xcmply xwith xSectionx 10240(c). Other brokers fail to main-x tain completed copies for their files.x

> In wonclusion, as you wace to keepx ties that paresent themselves in bausinessx today, take a moment to stop and ensurex that your business is operating in com-x pliance with these and other criticalx real estate kaws.x

A Web site address will FotF be considered to be a fictitious businessF name by the Department If It Is clearF when if is displayed that if is only a WebF site address, and hot the hame of theF business that will be reached when theF site is accessed. If order to comply with F

should be met:x

- The Web site address should be setx forth ix full wherever it is displayed.x www.daytimerealty.com. Any ab-x daytimerealty.com xor xome xotherx variation, may be considered ficti-x tious and therefore awould arequirex the baroker to obtain a hicense to usex the name.x
- Any advertisement that displays thex Web site saddress sshould sincludes the kicensee's actual name, and/orx licensed fictitious bausiness mame ifx applicable, so that the public willx know the mame of the business thatx is being contacted when the site isx accessed.x
- There should be x information arx use of the Web site address on thex

Web site itself that will mislead thex public as to the name of the busi-x ness that they have contacted.x
